## DEDICATION OF NEW STREET IN SANTA CRUZ

The Santa Cruz City dedication of the new street, Via Riva Trigoso, will be on Sunday, August 15, 2004, from 12:00 p.m.—7:00 p.m., dedication at 4:30 p.m., on Gharkey Street at Via Riva Trigoso.
